

Hoist Test Procedures

These test procedures shall be complied to, without exception, annually.

Slings shall undergo periodic load tests at least every year at a specific load test factor of the design rated load. All components shall be tested together as a system, if practical. Slings used infrequently for critical lifts shall be load tested for each critical lift if it has been over a year since the last load test.

SPECIFICATIONS

Rated capacity of Nacelle Mounted Hoist: 1,550 lbs

The hoist should be visually inspected before each use for signs of fatigue. This includes any cracks or irregularities resulting from use.


08-5004-0000, 08-0116-5000, AND 08-0132-0000 NACELLE MOUNTED HOISTS

- 1. Install hoist into weld/test fixture.
- 2. Increase cylinder pressures:

Cylinder 1: 190 psig + 10 psig (1,143 lbs)
Cylinder 2: 250 psig + 10 psig (1,526 lbs)
Cylinder 3: 241 psig + 10 psig (573 lbs)

Cylinder 3: 81 psig + 10 psig (573 lbs)


- 3. Hold fixture load for one (1) minute.
- 4. Slowly release cylinder pressure.
- 5. Visually inspect all parts for cracks and/or irregularities resulting from testing.
- 6. If any irregularities are found, parts are to be discarded or returned to Tronair for evaluation.

Z-1470, Z-1469-01 AND Z-1469-02 ENGINE STRAPS

- 1. Attach each strap separately to a Hydraulic Test Fixture and apply a hydraulic test load of 145 psig + 10 psig (1,530 lbs.) to strap.
- 2. Hold load for one (1) minute minimum.
- 3. Release load and visually inspect all parts for cracks and/or irregularities resulting from testing.
- 4. If any irregularities are found, parts are to be discarded or returned to Tronair for evaluation.



08-0136-0010 NACELLE MOUNTED HOIST

- 1. Modify trolley assemblies by replacing R-1859-01 with F-1602-B fixture component.
- 2. Mount nacelle mounted hoist on test stand.
- 3. Install fixture component into the trolley assemblies.
- 4. Install hydraulic cylinder and load cell.
- 5. Pull nacelle mounted hoist to 4,000 lbs and hold load for one (1) minute.
- 6. Remove hoist from the test fixture and inspect the entire system for any signs of failure.
- 7. Change trolley pins back to R-1859-01.
- 8. If any irregularities are found discard or returned to Tronair for evaluation.
